REGISTRATION GUIDELINES & PRICING for 2025 Junior Golf

Rolling Hills Golf Club presents a unique opportunity for young golfers, ages 6 to 17, to learn, play, and enjoy the game of golf! The objective of this program is to give junior golfers a complete overview of the many fundamentals of golf. Junior golfers will receive weekly group instruction on the Practice Facilities, followed by on-course play and tips from Coach Martin and Coach John.

The entry fee for Junior Golf is a one time fee with no additional weekly costs. With payment, Junior Golfers will receive a bag tag, a rule book, pre-season instructional clinics, and a certificate of completion at the end of the season at the awards banquet. During the season, junior golfers will receive discounts on instruction from the Head Golf Professional, Martin Hanna. Division placement is based upon age, ability, instruction and events. At the end of the season, a Junior Club Championship Tournament will be hosted for all Junior Golf groups.

- Each clinic is limited to 15 kids or less and we recommend that first time participants attend two clinics, while previous junior golfers are recommended to attend at least one

clinic. Junior golfers are limited to two clinics. This should ensure that everyone has an opportunity to meet and train with the golf coaches and be placed accordingly. Please call the pro-shop to sign up for clinics.

- The program will begin in the end of May / early June with Saturday and Sunday afternoon clinics. There will be no junior golf after Tuesday morning instruction, but we encourage families to make a tee time and spend the afternoon at the course.
- **We must have adult supervision in all level groups to allow them to play.**
- All Boys and Girls playing in the advanced division will be required to walk and carry their own golf bags or use their own pushcart. Beginner and intermediate divisions should walk while playing holes and ride in a cart between holes to help the pace of play. Golf bags can remain on the carts during play.
- Advanced boys will play from the Red/White Tees and the girls will play from the Red Tees. Intermediate boys and girls will play from markers set-up at 80-220 yards* in length. Beginner boys and girls will play from markers set-up at 60-130 yards* in length.
